FOOD ON THE RUN!

Quick Beer Bread

INGREDIENTS

- 750 ml SASKO BRAN RICH SELF – RAISING FLOUR (450 G)
- 4 ml mixed dried herbs
- 45 ml sugar (40 g)
- 400 g can whole kernel corn, drained
- 340 ml can beer

METHOD

1. Sift flour and add herbs, sugar and corn.
2. Gradually add the beer mixing well to bring the dough together.
3. Turn into a greased 23 cm x 13 cm loaf pan and bake at 180° c for 60 minutes.
4. Cool for 5 minutes before turning out onto a cooling rack.

* This bread is best eaten soon after it is made.

- Take note of who is leading and trailing you. If they disappear, inform run co-ordinators ASAP.
- Remain in the order in which you set out.
- Stops will be planned for the route, these to be adhered to.
- At obstacles, leave the vehicle in front of you sufficient room, enough to reverse if he needs to. When stopping on steep hills, bear the following vehicles in mind, which might have to pull away against that incline.
